Cookies policy for **torinosweethome.com****Use of cookies**

The "Site" (torinosweethome.com) uses cookies to make our services simple and efficient for users who view the pages of the site. Users viewing the site will see quantities added minimum information on the devices in use, which are computers and mobile devices, in small files of text called "cookies" saved in the directories used by the User's web browser. There are various types of cookies, some to make more effective use of the Site, others to enable certain features.

Analyzing them in detail, our cookies allow:

- memorize the preferences entered;
- avoid re-entering the same information several times during the visit, such as a name user and password;
- analyze the use of the services and content provided by the Site to optimize the experience of navigation and services offered.

Types of cookies**Technical cookies**

This type of cookie allows the correct operation of some sections of the Site. There are two categories: persistent and session:

- persistent: once the browser is closed they are not destroyed but remain up to a date of pre-set deadline
- session: they are destroyed every time the browser is closed

These cookies, always sent from our domain, are necessary to view the site correctly and in relation to the technical services offered, will therefore always be used and sent, unless the user does not change the settings in your browser (thus disrupting the display of site pages).

Analytical cookies

Cookies in this category are used to collect information on the use of the site will use these information regarding anonymous statistical analysis in order to improve the use of the Website and to make i content that is more interesting and relevant to users' wishes. This type of cookie collects data in anonymous form on the activity of users and how it arrived on the Site. Analytical cookies are sent from the Site Same or from third-party domains.

Analysis cookies for third-party services

These cookies are used in order to gather information on the use of the Site by users in anonymous form such as: visited pages, time spent, origins of originating traffic, geographical origin, age, gender and interests for the purpose of marketing campaigns. These cookies are sent from third-party domains external to the Site.

Cookies to integrate products and software functions**third parts**

This type of cookie integrates features developed by third parties within the pages of the site such as icons and preferences expressed in social networks in order to share site content or for use of third-party software services (such as software to generate maps and additional software they offer additional services). These cookies are sent from third-party domains and from partner sites that offer theirs functionality between the pages of the Site.

Profiling cookies

These cookies are necessary to create user profiles in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user within the pages of the Website.

The Site, according to current legislation, is not required to seek consent for cookies and technical analytics, as necessary to provide the requested services.

For all other types of cookies, the consent can be expressed by the user with one or more of one of the cookies following modes:

- By specific configurations of the browser used or related IT programs used to browse the pages that make up the site.
- By changing settings in the use of third-party services

Both of these solutions may prevent the user from using or viewing parts of the Website.

Web sites and third-party services

The Site may contain links to other Web sites that have their own information on the privacy that may be different from that adopted by the Site and therefore not responsible for these sites.

Information about cookies**_gat**

The _gat cookie is part of the Google Analytics analysis and monitoring service. It is a cookie that expires after 10 minutes after creation or update. It is used to block the number of requests of the analysis scripts in order to consider the user's visits unique.
